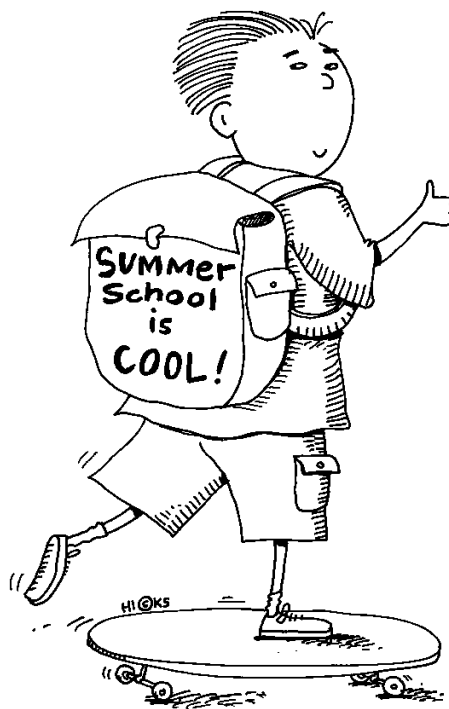


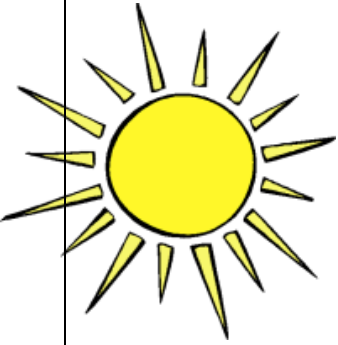

Registration

Information

- ✓ St. Mel Summer Adventure 2019 is open to students entering grades TK-6. Students should enroll in camps that are indicated for their grade level in the fall. Please use the registration form at the end of this packet.
- ✓ The afternoon Excellent Adventure Camp fees include weekly swimming at the Orangevale Community Pool. Snacks and drinks are provided.
- ✓ You will need one registration form for each child you are enrolling. You may find additional registration forms in the office, on-line, or you may copy the one in your packet.
- ✓ You will receive a packet prior to summer school with your registration confirmation and other important information. An invoice will also be sent home with payment fees & due dates.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

- ✓ Registration will not take place without payment of registration fees. It is important that students register by **April 5, 2019** to ensure their enrollment space in the requested sessions.
- ✓ Turn in one Emergency Information Request form per family at the time of registration. If you are currently enrolled in St. Mel School, you do not need to fill out an Emergency Information form.
- ✓ All fees must be paid prior to the beginning of St. Mel Summer Adventure. **There are no exceptions as fees are the sole support of the St. Mel 2019 Summer Adventure.** Students will not be admitted to class/camp without payment of fees.
- ✓ Drop in fees are due the day services are rendered.

- ✓ For your convenience, we offer a weekly registration option. We also have an option for students who wish to register on a daily basis. Before and After Camp Care is available from 7:30 – 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 – 5:30 P.M. Prices are listed on the invoice sheet.

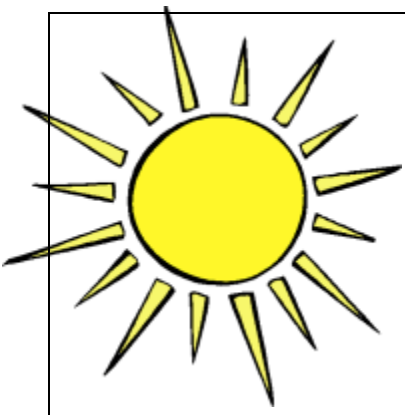
Learning Enrichment Adventure Reading & Math Class Description

Learning Enrichment Adventure Reading addresses the literacy needs of children at all levels of reading and writing ability. The program is Common Core based. Writing instruction will focus on the mechanics of writing and daily word work to build skills in phonemic awareness, spelling, and handwriting. Campers will expand their writing skills through expository narratives, descriptive writing, comparison/contrast, poetry, and for the older camper, five-paragraph essays. The classroom Apple TVs and the computer lab will be utilized to enhance the writing experience.

Learning Enrichment Adventure Math is Common Core based and designed to inspire a love of math and numbers in every camper! Campers will design projects, play games, and practice every-day practical skills to make math meaningful. Campers will have fun with math and see its relativity in their lives. They will participate in small group and individual centers, create artwork using math, practice fractions through cooking, and sewing, find patterns in music, and spend time using money skills and “shopping.” The classroom Apple TVs and computer lab will provide additional experiences for campers to enjoy the magic of math.

K.B.A.R. – Kick Back and Read offers students the opportunity to listen to exciting stories read aloud, to read quietly by themselves, or to read aloud to a teacher. Students may bring their own books or share books from our summer school library.
